

Enough and too

Enough goes after adjectives and adverbs. Enough normally goes before nouns. You can use enough alone (without noun). Compare too much/many and enough.

We say enough/too... for somebody/something. But we say enough/too... to do something (not for doing).

Lucy turned down the job. She earns enough money where she works at the moment.

She is mature enough to get married.
