

Be/ get used to something

It is not new or strange for someone. After be/get used you cannot use the infinitive (to do/to drive, etc.) When we say I am used to something, to is a preposition, not part of the infinitive.

Lo usamos cuando no resulta nuevo o extraño para alguien. Después de *be/get used* no podemos usar el infinitivo. El *to* que usamos es una preposición, no es parte del infinitivo.

Raul is used to living with his parents.

Lisa was used to working extra time.

Patricia's parents moved to a new recently purchased house. They are not used to driving long distances.
