

Capitalization

- Capitalize the first Word of a sentence.

Boxing was the most famous sport in the 60's.

- Capitalize all proper nouns and names. Capitalize a title that precedes a name:

Dr. Lorence

Mr. Henriquez

- Capitalize the names of racial and ethnic groups:

Latin

African

Cherokee

(Exception: Do not capitalize the words black or white when referring to racial groups.)

- Capitalize the names of specific geographical locations including countries, cities, town, rivers, streets, and mountains:

Ecuador

Riberas Street

Mount Everest

- Capitalize the days of the week, month, and holidays:

Friday

Easter

New Year's Eve

- Capitalize the names of religions:

Christianity

- Capitalize nationalities and languages:

Ecuadorian

Canadian

- Capitalize all words in a title except articles, prepositions, and conjunction, unless they are the first or the last word in the title:

Sound of Silence

Let's Call the Whole Thing off
